

2011 EU-China Year of Youth

ID 2010/11 MPhil/PhD Candidate Regina Martinez Enjuto has been designated to represent the Spanish Youth in the 2011 EU-China Year of the Youth

On January 11th 2011 the «2011 EU-China Year of Youth» was inaugurated in Brussels as an action plan to “further promote and deepen partnership between Europe and China”. The plan builds on existing relations between the EU and China, and aims to further policies to encourage education, employment and cultural relations and deepen the dialogue between the youth of these regions.

In a moment in which youth unemployment is reaching critical rates across Europe, the EU-China Year of Youth, which coincides with the European Year of Volunteering and the 10th Anniversary of the International Year of Volunteering, intends to put the youth at the centre of the political agenda as an engine for a sustainable development, encouraging volunteering activities and joint projects, supported by the EU Youth in Action Programme’s Youth in the World Action and the European Voluntary Service.
