The Robinson Rooms Suite comprises three interconnecting rooms. The largest seats up to 50 theatre style, but with its flexible furnishings can be easily and quickly configured to a variety of different room settings.

Two smaller adjoining rooms can be used as breakout areas for group work in conjunction with the larger space, or can be hired individually for smaller events and meetings.
