The Government has announced an additional bank holiday in 2011 to mark the Royal Wedding. The Easter Closure is adjusted for 2011 for this reason.

The Government has announced an additional bank holiday in 2012 to mark the Queen's Diamond Jubilee. The Spring Bank Holiday is delayed by a week to create a four-day weekend.

The Christmas Closure day on Friday 2 January 2015 is counted in the 2014 leave year when pro-rating leave allowances.
