Web Usability Testing - Guidelines for Observers

• Observe (!) the behaviour of the participants

Usability testing is about the users real actions – focus on what they **do**.

• Listen to the participants "thinking aloud"

Note down any relevant thoughts, particularly regarding navigation and wording.

• Make as many detailed notes as possible on the Observer Record form

Your notes are the test results!!

• Try not to jump to conclusions early in a test

Keep focussed on what the participant is actually doing.

• Don't interrupt the testing to talk to the participant.

Testing is a really uncomfortable situation; they need to forget you are there!

After each participant finishes his/her test there will be an opportunity to discuss the tests with the other observers and the facilitator.
