
Outer London Enquiry

A report on life and labour in West Ham, originally intended for extension throughout the East End, the project was curtailed due to lack of funding. The findings were published as a book: *West Ham: A Study in Social and Industrial Problems* (J.M. Dent and Co, London, 1907), by Howarth and Wilson. The inquiry relied upon rent books, obtained from house agents, and contains no actual survey data, being a collection of indirectly related material, including examples of analysis drawn from other surveys.
