


Variants of the 'star and cluster' model favoured by The Mayor's Outer London Commission








Manchester **A Monocentric City** Travel to Work

Manchester came out as a Monocentric cityregion. Others e.g. Leeds and Liverpool, show weak Polycentric characteristics



Manchester City Region








Employment Density in London


















Residential Incomes
