



- Settle into life in London.










The enrolment process

- From late August you will be sent an email inviting you to complete online preenrolment
- As part of online pre-enrolment you will activate your LSE IT account and LSE email address
- You will then have access to Moodle resources, events, course selection etc and can begin to explore what LSE has to offer!
- You will be able to download your PDF pre-enrolment pass which you should bring to campus enrolment.






The enrolment process

- Attend an in-person campus enrolment session in Marshall Building Great Hall.
 Dates & times can be found in the student hub app and on the <u>campus</u> <u>enrolment schedule</u> webpage.
- Right to study documents, e.g. passport, BRP or share code. Please check our <u>what to bring to campus enrolment</u> pages.
- LSE ID card which doubles up as your library card and provides access to on campus resources and teaching.

How can I get help to feel prepared before I start?

- Support with getting prepared to study at LSE before you start <u>Prepare to</u> Learn
- A short online course that you can complete before you arrive on campus both for undergraduate and postgraduate students
- Includes information on what it's like to learn at LSE
- Helps you to develop key skills for your everyday academic work
- Provides you with more information on where you can find help during your time here at LSE
- You can access the course once you've completed online pre-enrolment and set up your LSE IT account.

- Events across London LIFE in London









How do I know what's on during Welcome?

3. Check for emails from your department, halls of residence, and other areas of LSE










