Provide Passport details



In order to receive your Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) number, you will need to provide a copy of your passport as soon as possible. This *can* be after **30 April 2024.**

Please note that we will only be issuing CAS numbers from late June.

If you have an offer, it is recommended you accept it by **2 June 2024** to ensure you are able to meet the accommodation application deadline.
